In this course students will develop the foundational theory, practical proficiencies, customer service and consulting skills, and introduction to advanced techniques necessary to ensure adequate training for entry level positions in the hair industry.

Learning Objectives*	<p>Upon completion of this program the successful student will have reliably demonstrated the ability to: cut, colour and style hair according to an innovative system set out by The Industry Commercial Arts Institute creative director Aly McRae. Students will also receive training in areas of social media & self promotion and client management to students in providing customer service and thorough consultations while executing a range of basic hair design skills. Skills students can be expected to leave the program with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Advanced color theory knowledge and application skills ● in-depth awareness of foundations of hair cutting, using our 4 system cuts ● Ability to consult with client demonstrating the skills needed to apply knowledge ● Able to elevate the 4 foundation cuts to precision cutting services (clipper, short, and long length) ● Able to make product choices for effective washes and styles ● Has received a overview of industry practices such as tool care, hair anatomy, and hair industry history 	
Method(s) of Evaluation*	<p>Throughout the program students will be evaluated and coached on haircuts, colours, and styles by their supervisors. They will receive a written interim report and “one on one” coaching session with an educator. A practical midterm test will take place at the 3 month mark in the program.</p> <p>The successful student will be permitted access to hands-on training with clients after passing the practical midterm.</p>	

	Each student will be responsible for planning and executing a final project showcasing their learned skills according to project guidelines.
Completion Requirements*	Students will be required to achieve a mark of 75% or higher to graduate from this program. The student will need to display a mastery of practical skills, understanding and application of theoretical knowledge, and adherence to The Industry Institute policies.
Program Duration	Class will consist of 20 hours weekly and run for 26 weeks, for a total of 520 hours.
Homework Hours	Work will be kept within school hours.
